Proposed Barbecue Area Upgrade Yarraville Gardens

As part of the open space capital works program Council will be upgrading the Yarraville Gardens barbecue and picnic area.

The proposed works are shown on the plan below and include:

- A new asphalt path with bluestone edging connecting the public toilets, park entry, and picnic area
- A collection of picnic settings including a long table to accommodate larger groups
- Two barbecues (each with two hotplates) set apart from the tables
- Upgrade of seating and picnic settings near the playground
- New bin rubbish bins and drinking fountain
- New tree planting consistent with the heritage of the Gardens

Works are expected to occur in late 2016.
