Notice of the preparation of an amendment

Amendment C141

The Maribyrnong City Council has prepared Amendment C141 to the Maribyrnong Planning Scheme.

The Amendment affects all land in the City of Maribyrnong.

The amendment proposes to introduce Clause 22.08 – Licenced Premises into the Local Planning Policy Framework of the Maribyrnong Planning Scheme. The policy provides guidance on assessing amenity impacts of licensed premises that require a planning permit. The amendment also proposes associated changes to the Municipal Strategic Statement and the addition of *Managing the Impacts of Licensed Premises* as a reference document.

You may inspect the amendment, any documents that support the amendment and the explanatory report about the amendment, free of charge, at the following locations:

- during office hours, at the office of the planning authority, Maribyrnong City Council,
 Town Hall Corner of Napier and Hyde Streets Footscray.
- at the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning website www.delwp.vic.gov.au/public-inspection.

Any person who may be affected by the amendment may make a submission to the planning authority about the amendment. Submissions must be made in writing giving the submitter's name and contact address, clearly stating the grounds on which the amendment is supported or opposed and indicating what changes (if any) the submitter wishes to make.

Name and contact details of submitters are required for council to consider submissions and to notify such persons of the opportunity to attend council meetings and any public hearing held to consider submissions. The closing date for submissions is 19 December 2016. A submission must be sent to:

The planning authority must make a copy of every submission available at its office for any person to inspect free of charge for two months after the amendment comes into operation or lapses.
