

Combining the sound from two alternate locations, one slightly behind the other, it allows for a virtual double layering of space and time. Have your senses aroused through the Texture of Sound.

Take a guided walk and talk with a group of eclectic residents of a street in Footscray. Over 15 years the occupants have bonded and formed sincere friendships. The residents have had their children grow up and play together, share home cooking, swapped clothes and plant clippings and celebrated with parties. The commonality of the location is that all the houses boarder onto the railway line providing spectacular views of a developing suburb. Artist Daniela Rodriguez has documented this appealing street of neighbours. Experience their time living in this unique pocket of Footscray through projection, talks and performance.



METAMORPHOSIS THE INDIRECT OBJECT


