

Hansen Reserve, West Footscray

Draft Master Plan

The Master Plan proposes a variety of open space features and uses including:

- An expanded playspace offering junior and senior elements with a variety of active and nature play features, relocated to the centre of the reserve to maximise connectivity between uses,
- Improved pedestrian entries at Robert Street and Glamis Road and new entries at the southwest and southeast corners,
- New circuit path around the existing soccer fields in the north east corner of the reserve to allow for extended walking,
- Extensive tree and understorey planting,
- Lighting of the main east-west shared path between Glamis Rd and Robert St,
- A bike skills/learn to ride track,
- Picnic and barbecue facilities including shelters at two locations overlooking the playspace and the playing fields
- Facilities for older children and adults including an exercise station, a full sized basketball court; ½ size netball court and some skate edges/elements,
- Future redevelopment of the sports pavilion to better address multiple playing fields, which will incorporate a public toilet,
- Potential relocation of the EPA air monitoring station,
- Dog off-leash activity maintained on the playing fields and on-lead activity maintained in the south-west area,

The Master Plan delivers on recommendations of the Maribyrnong Open Space Strategy 2014.
